The Campbell River Killer Whales Swim Club is actively seeking a Head Coach commencing October 31st, 2009 or sooner. Campbell River is a vibrant community of over 30,000 residents located on the East Coast of Vancouver Island approximately 150 km north of Nanaimo. It is home to world class fishing, diving, boating, hiking and has a temperate climate all season long. Mt. Washington is located 30 minutes south where you will find amazing skiing, snowboarding, tubing and cross-country trails – all just outside your backyard.

The Killer Whales Swim Club was founded in 1979 and has developed during that time national Qualifiers, Provincial and National Record Holders and International competitors. It currently boasts 80 competitive swimmers with a strong 50 member swim school which runs in 12 week sessions. The Killer Whales currently are represented at regional, provincial and national levels including swimmers in the Provincial Team programs.

CRKW trains out of the Strathcona Gardens Recreation Center, a 6 lane – 25 meter pool with two separate teaching areas outside of the main pool. From June to August CRKW also has access to an outdoor 6 lane – 25 meter pool at Centennial Park.

The successful candidate will have head coaching experience or assistant coaching experience with a history of developing strong competitors. Full NCCP level 2 certification will be considered but preference will be given to coaches completed or close to completing their Level 3 or international equivalent.

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Lead coach of 12 swimmers
- Co-coach groups of twelve 12 and unders and twenty 10 and unders.
- Schedule all programs
- Meet entries, media reports and database maintenance (knowledge of HY-TEK a must).
- Monthly reports to executive and AGM report annually.
- Act as ex-officio member of executive; attend all meetings to act in a role of advisor.
- Staff hiring, dismissal, training, in-services and meetings.
- Liaison between executive and pool administration including bookings coordinator, head guard, program coordinator and general manager
- Recruiting through school and recreational programs
