## **HARRY BAILEY SCHOLARSHIP COACHES APPLICATION - 2007**

### **CRITERIA:**

In recognition of Mr. Harry Bailey's trust fund and his interest in education and the coaching profession, SWIM SASKATCHEWAN INC. hereby establishes the "**HARRY BAILEY SCHOLARSHIP**". The administration of the Scholarship shall be as follows:

- a) The Scholarship will be awarded on the advice of the Awards Committee of Swim Saskatchewan Inc.
- b) The Scholarship will be funded from the Harry Bailey Trust Fund and shall not exceed an amount of \$400.00 in any year.
- c) The Scholarship will be awarded for post secondary education. Preference will be given to those applicants who will work with indoor speed swimming clubs during the winter season if the opportunity presents itself or with an outdoor (summer) club during the summer season.

The Harry Bailey Scholarship will be awarded on the advice of the Awards Committee of Swim Saskatchewan Inc. under the following conditions:

1. Applicants must:
  - a) Be a graduate of a Saskatchewan High School.
  - b) Be a Canadian Citizen.
  - c) Have already attained Level One Theory and Technical Coaches Certification.
  - d) Have a minimum of four years competitive swimming experience in an organized competitive speed swimming club.
  - e) Have a good academic standing.
  - f) List leadership experiences.
  - g) List community involvement and extra curricula activities.
  - h) Write a 200-word essay on either:
    - i. "What Swimming Means to Me" OR
    - ii. "How Swimming Has Affected My Life"
  - i) Registered member of the SSCA in the 2007-2008 season

### **ONLY COACHES WHO MEET THE ABOVE CRITERIA SHOULD APPLY**

2. Scholarship funds to be applied towards expenses for full-time training at any accredited post-secondary institute in the Province of Saskatchewan.
3. The Scholarship shall be for an amount of \$400.00.
