

**We're Back for the 2022 Junior Provincials!**

Swim Saskatchewan and the Moose Jaw Kinsmen Flying Fins are excited to have you attending the 2022 Junior Provincials this weekend. This is our first provincial championship meet since March 2020 where Junior Provincials was our last championship meet prior to the pandemic and the first one back!

To help you prepare for the weekend ahead we want to provide you with some useful information, please use the hyperlinks for additional information. As per the sanctioned [meet package](#) and the [Feb 10 Swim Sask letter](#) to members the following Swim Sask Competition requirements will be in place for Junior Provincials this weekend:

- Masks will still be required for all swimmers, coaches, officials and volunteers, and the mask must be worn properly, over chin and nose, always except when in the pool.
- As this is the first weekend following the remove of Provincial restrictions and back to school following February break, we ask everyone attending to administer a home rapid test prior to attending the competition. If test positive, then you must stay home.
- Stay home if not feeling well or have Covid related symptoms.
- There will be no spectators.
- *We will no longer require those 12 years of age and older to provide proof of vaccination or negative test.*

We have 286 swimmers entered in the meet this weekend from all 11 Age Group clubs in Sask plus 32 coaches! Add in our volunteer officials and we will have over 300 people on the pool deck, and we want to be able to provide all 11 clubs with adequate space to spread out and not crowd. Therefore, to ensure families and friends can watch their swimmers compete, we are pleased to offer an alternate viewing experience **via live streaming**. Links to view are as follows:

A meet Referee may combine heats after entries are submitted. For this meet the following events have been combined:

**SESSION 1:** Events 13, 14, 15, 16 - girls swim together with a lane in between and the two boys swim together

**SESSION 2:** Events 45 and 46 - girls in lanes 3 and 4 and the boys in lanes 6 and 7

**SESSION 4:** Events 91 and 92 - girls in lanes 2, 3, 4 and boy in lane 6

Thank you for returning to swimming and travelling to Moose Jaw to compete at the 2022 Junior Provincials! We appreciate your cooperation and adherence to requirements set forth to provide a safe environment for all those in attendance. This is our first meet since 2020 with all swimmers of all ages in attendance at all sessions from all 11 Age Group in Saskatchewan! This is exciting!
