To Manitoba and Saskatchewan Swimming Community:

Swim Manitoba and Swim Saskatchewan staff recently met, and we would like to provide you an update for ManSask for this current 2021/2022 season.

Olympic Stream Time Standards

The 2016 to 2020 ManSask standards will remain in place for this current 2021-2022 season.

We will then review results and standards at the end of this season to evaluate if any changes are needed for the 2022/2023 and 2023/2024 season. Reminder that both SCM and LCM times are eligible.

Para Swimming Standards

The [2021-2022 Junior-Para Swimming Provincial Standards](#) will be used for this year. These standards are the same as the previous Provincial Para Swimming standards that Swimming Canada had in place prior to the pandemic and therefore using these stays in line with keeping the Olympic Stream standards the same for this year. SCM and LCM times are eligible.

Qualifying Period

The qualifying period for this year will be Sept 1, 2019 to the entry deadline date (2 weeks prior) for both the March and July 2022 competitions. As the Sask Junior Provincials are right after the 2 weeks, if there are swimmers who achieve their first "AA" time at Sask Junior Provincials, you will be able to submit entries for that swimmer(s) the after day after the conclusion of Junior Provincials.

Covid protocols/vaccination requirement

There will not be a standard requirement with regards to verification of vaccination status. Swim Manitoba policies will be in effect for the March competition held in Winnipeg and Swim Saskatchewan policies will be in effect for the July competition in Saskatoon. Keeping in mind of course, that the respective provincial government public health orders and facility requirements take precedence if either of those requirements are more stringent than the provincial swimming section. If the provincial section policy is more stringent then it applies, in the province the competition is hosted in.
