The North American Indigenous Games (NAIG) were held in Toronto July 16-23, 2017. Saskatchewan was represented by a team of 18 (14 swimmers and 4 staff). This un-sanctioned swim competition was part of the larger North American sporting and cultural gathering of Indigenous Peoples. The Games provides Indigenous youth, aged 13-19, an opportunity to showcase their athletic abilities through 14 sports and to celebrate their heritage through numerous cultural events.

Team Saskatchewan placed second overall next to Team British Columbia at the 2017 NAIG Games. 20 medal performances were achieved in these games.
