

1.2 BILLETING

- 1.2.1 SSI expects that winter swim clubs to provide billeting to the best of their ability for Saskatchewan swimmers at any sanctioned meet of more than one day duration, and for all Manitoba and Saskatchewan swimmers at provincial AA≅ Championships (a reciprocal agreement with Swim Manitoba is in place) and for participants in activities of the High Performance Program. Any other billeting shall be at the discretion of host clubs.
- 1.2.2 A standard form for billeting information is to be sent out with meet information. Information should include the name, sex and age of the swimmers, the approximate time of arrival and departure, and pertinent medical information such as allergies or specific conditions that require special care.
- 1.2.3 Clubs should require parents to submit billeting information about their swimmers and about their homes to facilitate the appropriate placement of swimmers.
- 1.2.4 Responsibilities when billeting:
- a. Host families are responsible for transporting swimmers to and from the pool on time.
 - b. Swimmers shall adhere to all household rules that have been established by the host family.
 - c. Swimmers shall remain under the direct supervision of the host family unless otherwise directed by the coach or chaperone. Swimmers **SHALL NOT** be left unsupervised.
 - d. Wholesome food shall be provided as required, depending upon the meet schedule. The minimum expectation is for a substantial breakfast and evening meal. Swimmers who make alternate arrangements are expected to notify the host family well in advance.
 - e. Billet gifts are not expected for hosting in-province swimmers.
- 1.2.5 A swimmer who misconducts himself or herself may be returned by the host family to the chaperone for the swimmer=s team and will not be billeted. A swimmer may be disciplined by the chaperone or other responsible team official, or by the meet manager or billet chairperson, provided that the swimmer must be told the nature of the conduct and must be given an opportunity to provide information concerning the incident. In such situations, sanctions shall be for the duration of the event only. Further sanctions may be applied in accordance with the SSI Discipline Policy.
