ELIGIBILITY: All swimmers must be amateurs and registered with Swim Saskatchewan as summer swimmers.

At meet managers discretion, registered summer swimmers from other provinces and from out of country may be invited to compete as either exhibition swimmers or competitive swimmers.

Age group based on age of swimmer as of April 30, 2010.

Only swimmers seven (7) years of age and older may compete in sanctioned competitions. Swimmers must be at least seven (7) years old as of April 30, 2010.

- COMPETITION:** SNC rules apply except as specifically modified herein.
- Age groups as per the summer swimming technical package:
7 & 8; 9 & 10; 11 & 12; 13 & 14; 15 – 17; 18 & Over
- All events will be swum as time finals.
- Male and female events will be swum separately,
except for 7 & 8 relays,
and where events may be swum together to maximize the use of
the pool.
- SEEDING:** All events will be pre-seeded according to time only and will be
swam slowest to fastest.
- SCRATCHES:** Scratches must be submitted to the Meet Manager at least
30 minutes prior to the start of competition. Scratch forms will
be available in the swim meet office.
- Scratches within a heat will not alter the pre-seeding and the
heat will be swum with empty lanes.
- START:** The FINA start shall be used for all events as per *SNC RULE
SW 4*. The one start rule will be used.
- NOTE:** At the Referee's discretion, swimmers may be required
to stay in the water, along the lane ropes, at the completion of
their race to allow for the next heat to begin, with the exception
of backstroke and relays.
- PROTESTS:** ALL infractions will be reported to the Referee and the Referee
will report the disqualifications to the coaches. Only a team's
coach may approach the Referees about a decision or complaint
and may submit protests as per *SNC RULE GR 9.2*.
- EVENTS:** A "List of Events" can be found at the end of this document.
- DECK ENTRIES:** **NO deck entries**
- RELAYS:** *To encourage camaraderie amongst swim clubs we will be
mixing swimmers from different clubs to form teams in their own
age group. No points will be received for the relays. If a
swimmer does not want to participate he/she must let the entries
personal know when sending the entries. Only the 100 free relay
will be listed.*
- ENTRIES:** All entries should be submitted by e-mail as a COMMLINK file
using the HY-TEK software (or on a 3 ½" computer disc.)
- A hard copy of entries must be sent as back up for electronic
submissions. This hard copy will be used to ensure that data is
transferred successfully from the Commlink file into Meet
Manager.

Grid sheets are also acceptable providing they contain all of the required information.

The swimmer's entire birth date (day/month/year) **MUST** be entered.

Swim times **MUST** be entered in short course meters. (**NOTE:** Even if the meet is being swum in yards (i.e. Melville) still enter times in short course meters.)

Swim Saskatchewan registration numbers **MUST** be submitted for each Saskatchewan swimmer. Entries for swimmers from out of province or out of Country must also include their summer swimming registration number. Meet Management will not be responsible for obtaining missing numbers. **Entries without registration numbers will not be accepted.**

Swimmers are limited to a **maximum of 5** individual events plus relays.

fifth – 2 points
sixth – 1 points

Gold, silver and bronze medals for accumulated points in each male and female age group. Ribbons for first, second,third, fourth, fifth and sixth place finishes.

CONCESSION: -A concession booth will be set up on the grounds west of the pool.

MEET SAFETY RULES: SNC warm-up procedures will be in effect at this meet, as per Appendix D in the SNC Rulebook.
During warm-ups, no swimmer shall enter the pool by a dive.

Exception: During the last 10 minutes of the warm-up period, when lanes 1 and 5 are designated as diving lanes. During this period, diving and one-way swimming only will be allowed in these lanes. After the dive the swimmer must exit the pool.

Safety Marshals will be on deck during warm-ups.

NOTE: It is the responsibility of the coaches to ensure that all swimmers are aware of and adhere to these safety rules, and to all rules of the facility.

Notes to Meet Managers:

- *7 and 8 Year old Relays may only be 100 meter relays. Relays for all other age groups may be offered as either 100 meter or 200 meter.*

- Ø *If a relay event is set up as Open then swimmers of any age can be entered in that relay (i.e. you could have a relay team made up of: one 8 year old swimmer, one 12 year old swimmer, one 14 year old swimmer and one 17 year old swimmer.*

- Ø *If a relay event is set up at 18 and Over then this event is for swimmers aged 18 and over except that as per item # 2.1.4.1 up to 2 swimmers from a younger age category may be moved up. (i.e. at least 2 of the swimmers must be aged 18 or older and 2 swimmers may be younger than 18.)*

- Ø *Up to two (2) swimmers from a younger age category may be moved to be part of a relay team in an older age group, except if the relay is offered as 'open' then swimmers of any age may participate*
